The August 10 oral hearing is to allow the Commission to hear oral final submissions from Indigenous Nations and communities that made oral interventions during Part 2 of the public hearing, and from CNL.

Participants that have requested the opportunity to make a final submission by way of oral statement are reminded that their final submissions are to summarize their position and/or opinion with respect to this matter. Final submissions may reference any material on the record but may not introduce any new information. On May 17, 2023, the Commission announced that it was satisfied with the information on the record relating to CNL's application and that it did not require any new information.

Each participant has been allotted 30 minutes to make their oral final submissions. CNL, as the proponent, will have up to 60 minutes.

Le 17 mai 2023, la Commission a annoncé qu'elle était satisfaite de l'information au dossier de la demande des LNC et qu'elle n'avait pas besoin de nouvelle information.

Chaque participant aura 30 minutes pour s'adresser à la Commission. Les LNC, en tant que promoteurs, auront un maximum de 60 minutes.
