Upcoming public meeting on the Regulatory Oversight Report for Canadian Nuclear Laboratories Sites: 2023

The <u>Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission</u> (CNSC) will hold a public meeting in November 2024, where CNSC staff will present the *Regulatory Oversight Report for Canadian Nuclear Laboratories Sites: 2023* (CNL ROR). The facilities and activities covered by the CNL ROR are located in the traditional and treaty territories of many Indigenous Nations and communities. This revised notice is to announce a change to the meeting date and location. The meeting will now be held on November 7-8, 2024, in the Outaouais Room, 140 Promenade du Portage, Gatineau, Quebec, and virtually via Zoom.

CNSC staff will provide an overview of the CNSC's regulatory efforts related to licensed CNL sites, including:

- Chalk River Laboratories
- Douglas Point Waste Facility
- Gentilly-1 Waste Facility
- Nuclear Power Demonstration Waste Facility
- Port Hope Area Initiative, consisting of the Port Hope and Port Granby projects
- Whiteshell Laboratories

The public meeting will be webcast live and available on the CNSC website at <u>nuclearsafety.gc.ca</u>.

The CNL ROR will be available for review on request to the Registry after August 8, 2024.

Participant funding

In advance of the public meeting, the CNSC offered up to \$75,000 in funding through its <u>Participant Funding Program</u> (PFP). The purpose of the funding was to assist Indigenous Nations and communities, members of the public and interested parties in reviewing the CNL ROR, and



in participating in the Commission meeting process by providing topic-specific written submissions to the Commission. The deadline for submitting a completed participant funding application form to the CNSC was **April 19, 2024**. A funding review committee, independent of the CNSC, was established to review the funding applications, and recommended <u>reimbursement</u> to 8 applicants.

Interventions

Persons who have an interest or expertise in this matter are invited to comment, in writing, on the CNL ROR by October 7, 2024, using the <u>online request form</u>, <u>email</u>, or the contact information below. The submission must include your name, address, telephone number and email address. In addition, in the spirit of reconciliation and in recognition of the Indigenous oral tradition for sharing knowledge, Indigenous intervenors may make oral presentations if interested. Oral presentations may be conducted remotely. The request to intervene must include the following information:

- a written submission of the comments to be presented to the Commission
- a statement setting out whether the requester wishes to intervene by way of written submission only or by way of written submission and oral presentation
- the requester's name, address, telephone number and email address

Oral presenters who wish to use a PowerPoint presentation are asked to submit their slide decks to the Commission Registry by October 30, 2024. All submissions will be available for download on the CNSC website or on request to the Registry. Personal information, such as address and telephone number, is essential for linking the submission to its author. If you wish to ensure the confidentiality of your personal information, please submit it on a separate page.

Individuals who require Indigenous language interpretation for the meeting are asked to contact the Commission Registry by August 30, 2024, to request interpretation services. If the request is received after this date, the Commission Registry will do its best to provide such services.
