Upcoming public meeting on the *Regulatory Oversight Report for Uranium and Nuclear Substance Processing Facilities, Research Reactors, and Class IB Accelerators in Canada: 2023*

The [Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission](#) (CNSC) will hold a public meeting in February 2025, where CNSC staff will present the *Regulatory Oversight Report for Uranium and Nuclear Substance Processing Facilities, Research Reactors, and Class IB Accelerators in Canada: 2023* (ROR). The facilities covered by the ROR are located in the traditional and treaty territories of many Indigenous Nations and communities across Canada. **This revised notice of Commission meeting is to announce a change to the meeting date and the deadlines for submissions. The meeting will now be held on February 26, 2025. The ROR will now be available after September 9, 2024. Interventions are now due by January 11, 2025.**

CNSC staff will provide their assessment of the safety performance of the following Canadian facilities for the following reporting years:

- uranium and nuclear substance processing facilities in 2023
- research reactors from 2021 to 2023
- Class IB accelerators from 2020 to 2023

The public meeting will be webcast live and available on the CNSC website at cnsccsn.gc.ca.

The ROR will be available for review on the CNSC website, or on request to the Registry, after **September 9, 2024**.

Participant funding

In advance of the public meeting, the CNSC offered up to **\$50,000** in funding through its [Participant Funding Program](#) (PFP). The purpose of the funding was to assist Indigenous Nations and communities, members of the public and interested parties in reviewing the ROR, and in participating in the Commission meeting process by providing topic-specific written submissions to the Commission. The deadline for submitting a completed participant funding application form to the CNSC was **May 24, 2024**. A funding review committee, independent of the CNSC, has been established to review funding applications.

Interventions

Persons who have an interest or expertise in this matter are invited to comment, in writing, on the ROR by **January 11, 2025** using the [online request form](#), [email](#), or the contact information below. In addition, in the spirit of reconciliation and in recognition of the Indigenous oral tradition for sharing knowledge, Indigenous intervenors may make oral presentations if interested. Oral presentations may be conducted remotely. **The request to intervene must include the following information:**

- a written submission of the comments to be presented to the Commission
- a statement setting out whether the requester wishes to intervene by way of written submission only or by way of written submission and oral presentation
- the requester's name, address, telephone number and email address

Oral presenters who wish to use a PowerPoint presentation are asked to submit their slide decks to the Commission Registry by February 18, 2025. All submissions will be available for download on the CNSC website or on request to the Registry. Personal information, such as address and telephone number, is essential for linking the submission to its author. If you wish to ensure the confidentiality of your personal information, please submit it on a separate page.

Individuals who require Indigenous language interpretation for the meeting are asked to contact the Commission Registry by October 25, 2024, to request interpretation services. If the request is received after this date, the Commission Registry will do its best to provide interpretation services.
