Upcoming public meeting on the Regulatory Oversight Report for Uranium Mines, Mills, Historic and Decommissioned Sites in Canada: 2023

The <u>Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission</u> (CNSC) will hold a public meeting in January 2025, where CNSC staff will present the *Regulatory Oversight Report for Uranium Mines, Mills, Historic and Decommissioned Sites in Canada: 2023* (ROR). The facilities covered by the ROR are located in the traditional and treaty territories of many Indigenous Nations and communities across Canada.

The ROR provides an annual update on the regulatory performance of CNSC-licensed facilities and on CNSC staff's oversight activities at those facilities. The ROR covers activities that occurred in the 2023 calendar year at the operating sites, as well as activities that occurred between 2021 and 2023 at the decommissioned and historic sites.



The ROR will be available for review on the CNSC website, or on request to the Registry, after **October 10, 2024**.





Participant funding

In advance of the public meeting, the CNSC is making available up to \$75,000 in funding through its Program. The purpose of the funding is to assist Indigenous Nations and communities, members of the public and interested parties in reviewing CNSC staff's ROR, and in participating in the Commission meeting process by providing topic-specific written and/or oral submissions to the Commission. Applications for participant funding must clearly demonstrate how the proposed intervention will provide the Commission with information directly related to the ROR. Please note that the \$50,000 will be disbursed among all successful applicants. The deadline for submitting a completed participant funding application form to the CNSC is July 26, 2024.

Interventions

Persons who have an interest or expertise in this matter are invited to comment, in writing, on the ROR by **December 10, 2024**, using the <u>online request form</u>, <u>email</u>, or the contact information below. In addition, in the spirit of reconciliation and in recognition of the Indigenous oral tradition for sharing knowledge, the CNSC will offer Indigenous intervenors the opportunity to make oral presentations. Oral presentations may be conducted remotely. **The request to intervene must include the following information:**

- a written submission of the comments to be presented to the Commission
- a statement setting out whether the requester wishes to intervene by way of written submission only or by way of written submission and oral presentation
- the requester's name, address, telephone number and email address

Oral presenters who wish to use a PowerPoint presentation are asked to submit their slide decks to the Commission Registry by **3PM on January 15, 2025**. All submissions will be available for download on the CNSC website or on request to the Registry. Personal information, such as address and telephone number, is essential for linking the submission to its author. If you wish to ensure the confidentiality of your personal information, please submit it on a separate page.

Individuals who require Indigenous language interpretation for the meeting are asked to contact the Commission Registry by **July 10, 2024**, to request interpretation services. If the request is received after this date, the Commission Registry will do its best to provide interpretation services.
