# Upcoming public meeting on the 2024 regulatory oversight reports

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a public meeting the week of March 23, 2026, to consider the 5 regulatory oversight reports (RORs) for the 2024 calendar year:

- Regulatory Oversight Report for Canadian Nuclear Power Generating Sites: 2024
- Regulatory Oversight Report for Uranium and Nuclear Substance Processing Facilities in Canada: 2024
- Regulatory Oversight Report for Uranium Mines and Mills in Canada: 2024
- Regulatory Oversight Report on the Use of Nuclear Substances in Canada: 2024
- Regulatory Oversight Report for Canadian Nuclear Laboratories Sites: 2024

In these RORs, CNSC staff will provide their assessment of the safety performance of licensees in their respective sectors. The facilities and activities covered by the 2024 RORs are located in the traditional and treaty territories of many Indigenous Nations and communities, as described in each report.

The public meeting will be webcast live and available on the CNSC website at cnscccsn.gc.ca.

The 2024 RORs will be available for review on the CNSC website or on request to the Registry, after November 28, 2025. As part of efforts to continuously improve, the Commission will take the following approach to considering the 2024 RORs:



- The 2024 RORs will be considered as written submissions only.
- CNSC staff will not make formal presentations on the 2024 RORs.
- Intervenors will be invited to make one intervention covering any/all of the 2024 RORs (as described below).
- The Commission will ask questions during the public Commission meeting.

The Commission's approach to considering the information provided in RORs may change in future years as efforts to bring timely information before the Commission continue.

#### Interventions

Persons who have an interest in the 2024 RORs are invited to comment in writing. To simplify the process while ensuring meaningful participation, **persons seeking to intervene are invited to submit 1 written intervention**. This intervention may address any or all of the 2024 RORs.

In the spirit of reconciliation and in recognition of the Indigenous oral tradition for sharing knowledge, Indigenous intervenors may make oral presentations if interested. Oral presentations may be conducted in person or remotely and, as with the written interventions, may address any or all of the 2024 RORs.

Requests to intervene must be filed with the Commission Registry by January 28, 2026, using the <u>online request form</u>, by emailing the Registry at <u>interventions@cnsc-ccsn.gc.ca</u>, or by using the contact information below. The request to intervene must include the following information:

- a written submission of the comments to be presented to the Commission, clearly specifying to which 2024 ROR(s) the comments apply
- a statement setting out whether the requester wishes to intervene by way of written submission only or by way of written submission and oral presentation
- the requester's name, address, telephone number and email address

All submissions will be available for download on the CNSC website or upon request to the Commission Registry. Personal information, such as address and telephone number, is essential for linking the submission to its author. If you wish to ensure the confidentiality of your personal information, please submit it on a separate page.

## Participant funding

In advance of the public meeting, the CNSC is making up to \$300,000 in funding available through its Participant Funding Program. The purpose of the funding is to assist Indigenous Nations and communities, members of the public, and interest holders in reviewing the 2024 RORs, and in participating in the Commission meeting process by providing topic-specific written submissions to the Commission. The available funding is for all 2024

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RORs, and applicants need to submit only 1 funding application, even if their intervention addresses multiple RORs. Applicants must clearly specify in their application which 2024 ROR(s) their proposed intervention will cover.

A funding review committee, independent of the CNSC, will be established to review funding applications. Please note that the \$300,000 will be disbursed among all successful applicants. The deadline for submitting a completed participant funding application form to the CNSC is **August 25, 2025**.
