Submission

Written Submission: I am writing to express my strong opposition to any new reactors at Darlington. Nuclear power is both the most dangerous and the most expensive way to generate electricity. It also produces nuclear waste, which remains radioactive and therefore dangerous for a very long time, and for which no safe disposal or storage method has been found. We do not need nuclear power, as renewables such as wind and solar are getting cheaper and better all the time. Energy conservation and better building design are also very important as they can reduce the need for electricity. So long as we use nuclear reactors in Ontario we are exposed to the risk of nuclear accident, which could necessitate massive evacuations of people: Just because it has not happened here does not mean it never could. Please think what you are doing and end the madness.
