To whom it may concern,

My name is Adam Vicente and I am an owner at [REDACTED] Dupont St in Toronto. I would like to go on record as AGAINST BWXT landsdowne plants 10 year license renewal. I feel a plant that processes uranium should not be allowed in such a densely populated area. Population in this area has increased 20 times what it was when the plant (formerly Hitachi) started. This area was sparsely populated then, and there were a number of other facilities (such as GE) in the area. At one point this area was considered Toronto's most polluted land. It made an ideal location at that time, but no longer. Since then, there have been dozens of developments built with more on the way at the Galleria Mall redevelopment.

There is just too much risk involved for a plant that processes what could be considered, "weapons grade" uranium to be allowed in an urban area as populated as this.
