10 Year Licence Nuclear Pelleting Concerns

Accidents & Liability Insurance

- Zero L I as per CNSC & BWXT Agreement!
- It is an industrial REALITY that ACCIDENTS DO HAPPEN! (Explosions, chemical spills, radioactive dust and water contamination can occur due to human error, mechanical or electrical equipment failure, or terrorist threat!)
- LIABILITY INSURANCE is needed for the heart of Peterborough city!
- 2 km impact zone = 25,000 people includes 8 schools & the hospital!
- e.g. \$3.8M equates to \$152 pp THIS IS NOT ACCEPTABLE!
- \$3.8M equates to 38 victims at \$100K each but there are more than 38 kids playing in the school playground AND hundreds of homes nearby!
- Realistically, **\$2.5B** equates to \$100K pp MINIMUM for 25,000 victims!
- Eliminate need for Federal Taxes (OUR MONEY) for any clean-up!
- Risk of CITY WIDE & REGION damage to reputation as a tourist area
- Accidents are a major reason NOT to grant the 10 year licence!

Nuclear Industrial Location in Peterborough

- 10 year licence for flexibility is vague & of ALARMING concern!
- NO buffer zone to residents & schools is also cause for ALARM!
- We demand total safety; MITIGATION IS NOT ACCEPTABLE!
- MOVE the city OR nuclear industry located in the heart of Peterborough!

- 100+ year location is now PERPETUATING an increasing toxicity problem

*

- Big opportunity for governments to begin clean-up & rezone to residential.
- Use land to recoup expenses for clean-up and resell it to developers. This will help to reduce the housing crisis & increase tax revenues needed for city maintenance of infrastructure.
- AGAIN: Granting 10 year licence perpetuates this toxic scenario!

Conclusion

- NO federal taxes should be used for any industrial accident clean-up. Instead, appropriate Liability Insurance should be mandatory.
- E A needs to include a safety Buffer Zone in case of a potential major accident.
