I would propose that the route currently used by trucks removing nuclear waste that runs along Strachan be rerouted to one of the various side streets off of Bramley St. S that are north and south of Strachan.

The reasons for this proposal are:

- (1) this route was previously agreed in respect of the original timeline and the proposal leads to continued noise and disruption for residents along the route for considerably longer than anticipated;
- (2) the Mason homes subdevelopment is now complete and through traffic connects through Strachan, adding a lot more stress/congestion/emissions to the route;
- (3) the make up of the neighbourhood has changed, with many more children present and playing along the route; and
- (4) there are multiple alternative routes that would be just as, if not more, efficient and it would be more equitable to change the route to another street at this time.
