



LICENCE REVOCATION REQUESTMN-S TECHNICAL REVIEW



Summary of Findings – Engagement & Indigenous Interests Review

- Orano's engagement in this regulatory process has been inadequate
- Orano focused on one-way information sharing with NR2 and MN-S versus engaging in such a way that allows for an exchange of ideas and expectations
- Orano only provided written correspondence to LTMMP technical review project but no meeting






Summary of Findings – Engagement & Indigenous Interests Review

- Orano revise LTMMP to include monitoring and procurement opportunities for the Métis and Métis knowledge and traditional use in and around the Project
- NR2, MN-S, and Métis Locals to review revised LTMMP prior to any licence revocation
- Orano and the Government of Saskatchewan need to adequately consult and involve NR2, MN-S, and Métis Locals throughout the implementation of the LTMMP including providing funding for related participation




Summary of Findings – Ecological Review

- Involve NR2, MN-S, Métis locals, and Métis Citizens in the LTMMP sampling programs and results
- Provide engagement funding
- Revise surface water sampling to include Fe
- Explain selection of reference lakes
- Update fish tissue sampling guideline
- Include Métis knowledge in long-term monitoring and revision of the LTMMP




Summary of Findings - Geotechnical Review Orano's LTMMP lacks groundwater sampling needed to signal a water quality issue before surface water quality is impacted Orano needs to include more stringent water quality standards i.e., SSWQO to limit effects to the quality of aquatic and terrestrial ecosystems that Métis rely on for traditional use purposes Orano needs to conduct a geotechnical inspection after the first extreme weather event to confirm and ensure the site performs as anticipated Orano needs to consult NR2 and MN-S to determine LTMMP sampling locations, frequencies, and involvement opportunities Orano needs to engage NR2 and MN-S to establish a notification process if long-term monitoring shows risk of potential detrimental impacts to traditional use activities




