EXTERNAL EMAIL – USE CAUTION / COURRIEL EXTERNE – FAITES PREUVE DE PRUDENCE

My main concern is the proposal by Ontario Power Generation for 4 BWRX-300 reactors on the existing site of the Darlington CANDU reactors. My understanding is that this project has been given a CNSC license to “prepare the site” based upon the recommendations of an Environmental Assessment Report prepared by the Joint Review Panel in 2011.

Have the concerns raised by the JRP been addressed? I can find nothing to suggest that they have.

A 2011 EPA is not sufficiently up to date to make me feel comfortable - especially when the discussion now seems to entail four absolutely new untested and never constructed nuclear reactors.

I recommend that this entire process be reviewed and the highest of safety standards be met before the ground is turned. The Darlington Site is within spewing distance of the one of the largest and most densely populated areas in Canada. Luck is not an environmental plan.
