

Our support

- There is increased demand for low-carbon electricity such as nuclear
- Durham Region is an informed, experienced and willing host community
- The Region supports the Darlington New Nuclear Project





Host Community Challenges

- The multi-level governance structure of the nuclear sector presents significant challenges for host communities like Durham Region
- CNSC relies on host communities for information on local impacts, but communities are not adequately equipped to provide this effectively
- The full cost of the nuclear sector is subsidized by Durham Region property taxpayers



Call to Action:

- 1. The CNSC should establish MOUs with host municipalities to ensure resources to participate in regulatory processes and regulatory document reviews
- 2. Mandate a comprehensive review of the financial arrangements between nuclear operators, the province, and host communities as a condition of licencing
- 3. Identify host community challenges as a priority for ministerial support
