Matters for Discussion


Outlined below are the key issues that have been raised and discussed among our members. We are committed to working collaboratively to find solutions that honor our traditions and sustain our livelihoods.

- To date, there has been no consultation with us, the traditional land users. We feel our voices and perspectives have not been included in decisions affecting our lands.
- We have not received any correspondence from NexGen Energy Ltd. up to this date, which has contributed to a sense of exclusion from important discussions and developments.
- Our land users have concerns regarding the protection of habitat, both on land and in water. Safeguarding these environments is essential for the continued practice of our traditional activities and for the wellbeing of our community.

We respectfully request that you prioritize these concerns and work with us toward meaningful engagement and solutions. Our community stands ready to collaborate in protecting our shared environment and supporting the continuation of our traditions.

Thank you for your attention to these matters. We look forward to meeting with you to building a constructive relationship for the benefit of all.
