## Commission Ruling on Request to Protect Confidential Information under Rule 12, Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure

**Requestor:** Cameco Corporation (Cameco)

Matter: CMD 25-H3—Ruling on request to take measures to protect information in relation to

Cameco's application to release the final set of decommissioned Beaverlodge mine and mill site properties from CNSC licensing for acceptance into Saskatchewan's

Institutional Control Program

**Proceeding:** Public Hearing to be held on <u>January 30, 2025</u>

With respect to the matter noted above, the Commission has considered Cameco's <u>request for confidentiality</u> for the following document. This request was made pursuant to rule 12 of the <u>Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure</u> (the Rules).

In its consideration of Cameco's request for confidentiality, the Commission also considered <u>CNSC</u> <u>staff's review</u><sup>2</sup> of Cameco's request.
