BWXT, a company with a 107 year history of supplying the nuclear industry and a major supplier of large components to CANDU reactors around the world appreciates the opportunity to provide written feedback to the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) on Bruce Power's application to amend the licensing basis for Bruce A and Bruce B nuclear generating stations to increase their reactor power limits at a hearing in writing scheduled for July, 2026, Ref. 2026 H-104.

With full confidence in the ability of Bruce Power to safely implement the proposed changes, I am writing this letter in support of the request from Bruce Power requesting Commission approval to operate up to the intermediate power levels (IPLs) as part of Project 2030, with a goal of achieving 7,000MW from the Bruce Power site by the early 2030's.

The successful completion of Project 2030 will support climate change targets, future clean energy needs, and increase the available energy that will be required by companies like BWXT with increasing energy demand per the most recent IESO forecast.

The ability to leverage in a safe manner and thus increase energy output from an existing asset makes operational as well as cost effective sense, and it is our hope the CNSC will grant the request to amend the licensing basis for Bruce A and Bruce B nuclear generating stations to increase reactor power levels.
