### PURPOSE

The purpose of this memorandum is to provide CNSC Staff's comments to the Commission regarding the matter of Bruce NGS A and B (Bruce Power) request to protect from public disclosure the document submitted in the request for confidentiality:

*Supplemental Application for Waste Strategy and Security Impacts*

The CNSC Registry subsequently requested that CNSC staff provide their advice to the Commission on the Matter.

### DISCUSSION

To CNSC staff's knowledge, Bruce Power's documents provided in the confidentiality request have not been made available elsewhere publicly. The documents listed in this table have consistently been treated as confidential in CNSC staff's dealings with Bruce Power.



CNSC staff reviewed the document and related details provided by Bruce Power. Relevant information, along with CNSC staff's comments, is included in Table 1. For this document, Bruce Power has requested that the entire content be kept confidential.

## **CONCLUSION**

CNSC staff have reviewed Bruce Power's request for confidentiality to assess whether the proposed request is appropriate. CNSC staff's recommendation is for Bruce Power's request to be accepted by the Commission.
