Commission Ruling on Request to Protect Confidential Information

Requestor: Cameco Corporation

Subject: 26-H3, Cameco Corporation – Application to renew the Class IB Fuel Facility Operating Licence for its Port Hope Conversion Facility

Proceeding: Hearing to be held November 3 to 5, 2026

The Commission is satisfied that:

- as per subrules 12(1)(a) and 12(1)(b) of the *Rules*, the documents listed in Table 1 contain national or nuclear security elements and contain confidential information of a financial, commercial, scientific, or technical nature that is treated consistently as confidential; and
- as per subrules 12(2)(a) and 12(2)(b) of the *Rules*, protecting the information outweighs in importance the public interest in public hearings and disclosure of evidence, and the measures are designed so as not to affect the public nature of the proceeding except to the extent necessary to adequately protect the information

Therefore, applying subrules 12(3)(b) and 12(3)(c) of the *Rules*, the Commission requires that the publication and disclosure of information given to the Commission identified in Table 1 be restricted.
