Complete your notice of licence using the following instructions for each numbered section:

- 1. The licensee may use either their name, location or a combination of both. The choice should mirror what is most recognizable by members of the public.
- 2. The summary must include a description of the licensed activities AND an overview of prescribed equipment and nuclear substances contained at the site. The descriptions may be consolidated if the activities take place at the same location.

Some examples:

Operate and service medical accelerators and other radiotherapy facilities and conduct manual brachytherapy and possess, import, export, transfer and store sealed sources.

Operate and service an isotope production accelerator and possess, import, export, process, transfer, and store unsealed nuclear substances.

Possess, use, store, transfer, import, export and conduct licensed activities with unsealed nuclear substances.

Possess, use, store, transfer, import, export and conduct licensed activities with sealed nuclear substances.

Possess, use, store, transfer, import, export and conduct licensed activities with radiation devices.

Possess, store, transfer, import, export and service radiation devices.

Possess, use, store, transfer, import, export and conduct licensed activities with unsealed nuclear substances, sealed nuclear substances and radiation devices.

- 3. Location need not be specific; the radiation safety office or building name is sufficient.
- 4. The position of the person responsible for licence maintenance is preferred (e.g., radiation safety officer), however listing the name of the individual is acceptable.
