Industry Issue This document adds the requirement to post a summary of probabilistic safety assessments on licensee websites. This requirement is also included as guidance under Section 5 of REGDOC 2.4.2, Safety Analysis: Probabilistic Safety Assessment. Listing identical requirements in two different REGDOCs can result in inconsistencies and confusion.
