Comment: I would suggest referencing an established padlock standard such as ES12320 instead of using vague phrases such as "be of good quality". ES12320 has six levels of security and I would suggest mandating a minimum security level based on the risks presented by the sealed source. The manufacturers of locks that meet these standards already have key systems that prevent unauthorized copying which is also necessary in a good security program.
