Dear Sir or Madam,

The purpose of this memorandum is to communicate comments from Nordion (Canada) Inc. on the CNSC Discussion Paper DIS-14-09, "Modernizing the CNSC's Regulations", originally provided to Nordion via e-mail on November 17, 2014. [1]

At this time, Nordion does not have any feedback to provide the CNSC on DIS-14-02, however Nordion will continue to monitor the CNSC's ongoing efforts to update its framework for regulating the nuclear sector in Canada.

Nordion is currently working through its re-licensing process and if the Commission renews the Nordion Class 1B license, Nordion will have for the first time an associated License Condition Handbook (LCH). As such, Nordion may have comments at future opportunities, once the LCH has been issued and Nordion has assessed the regulatory framework for its licensing requirements as set-out in the LCH.
