RE : Comments on Comments DIS-16-05 Human Performance

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on comments received by CNSC on DIS-16-05 Human Performance.

It was disappointing to see that no-one locally involved with Human Resources or union representation in health care commented on DIS-16-05 (they were made aware).

I fully support the comments from **licensees** such as CNL, Nordion, NB Power, Bruce Power, OPG & Cameco. To quote from CNL's response: "CNL feels that there is no need for a REGDOC on human performance." I could not have said that better myself. From Nordion's response: "In summary, Nordion is strongly opposed to this implementation of a formal human performance program and recommends that the CNSC discontinue the process associated with DIS-16-05, "Human Performance". Should the CNSC decide to proceed, Nordion recommends a graded approach which would take into consideration existing programs." I fully agree with a graded

approach if a decision is made that that the suggested program, which would be a huge administrative burden, is actually necessary.

I am in agreement with the comments from TRIUMF with regard to Questions 6 & 7 as well as from SBRT with regard to their responses, paragraph 2 regarding Question 6, paragraph 3 regarding Question 7 and paragraph 1 regarding Question 8.
