Commission Ruling on Request to Protect Confidential Information

Requestor: Ontario Power Generation Inc.

Matter:24-H5— Application to extend the operation of Pickering Nuclear Generating
Station Units 5 to 8 until December 31, 2026

Date of proceeding: Public hearing, held on June 19 and 20, 2024

Where the Commission has ruled in favour of confidentiality, the Commission is satisfied that:

- as per subrules12(2)(a) and 12(2)(b) of the *Rules*, protection of the information outweighs in importance the public interest in public hearings and disclosure of evidence, and the measures are designed so as not to affect the public nature of the proceeding except to the extent necessary to adequately protect the information; and
- as per subrule 12(3)(b) of the *Rules*, the publication of information given to the Commission or designated officer be restricted or prohibited.
