Bonjour,

The Commission authorizes OPG's request for the restart of OPG Pickering Units 6, 7 and 8 and OPG Darlington 1 and 4 following any planned or unplanned outages, subject to all other pressure tube fitness for service requirements in the licensing basis being satisfied.

The Commission has determined that Pickering Unit 6, 7 and 8 and Darlington 1 and 4 have satisfied the terms of the DO Order and that, consequently, these units are no longer subject to the DO Order. A record of decision, including reasons for decision, will follow at a later date.

The Commission wishes to extend its appreciation to the participants for an efficient and productive approval process, recognizing that it was an accelerated and intensive process.
