To Whom It May Concern:

I am writing this email as a very concerned cottager who has a cottage just south of the Chalk River Nuclear Centre. I live in Toronto and this is a written intervention and I do not wish to make a presentation in January.

I am very distressed by all I read and hear regarding plans for a ten year license for CNL. I am very alarmed by the lack of supervision of how they would run Chalk River and that they will be under the supervision of AECL who apparently is in total disarray according to the Auditor General and should not be overseeing anything. Clean up of any leakage from Chalk River must be a major priority and there appears to be no environmental management of any sort and no limitations seem to have been set. The main details that matter are environmental and the health and welfare of the inhabitants of all who live along the Ottawa River. Apparently 28 of the 56 current licence conditions are being removed.

The only thing that matters is the health and protection of the population around the Ottawa River and anything that puts this in jeopardy is completely irresponsible and unacceptable. I lodge the most serious complaint about what is happening at CNL.
