#### **IPPAS Mission Overview**


- Canada is the 43rd country to host an IPPAS mission
- This was the 68th mission conducted by the IAEA since 1995
- Canada is one of the first countries to request that all five IPPAS modules be included in the comprehensive review:
  - national-level review
  - facility-level review
  - transport review
  - security of radioactive sources
  - computer security

### Mission Scope

The IPPAS mission included visits to the CNSC and four nuclear facilities:

- Bruce Nuclear Generating Station
- McMaster Nuclear Reactor
- OPG's Western Used Fuel Dry Storage Facility
- Nordion
