Minutes of the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Meeting held on Tuesday December 8, 2020 On Tuesday December 8, 2020, the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission held a public meeting on the matters set out in the <u>agenda CMD 20-M40.A</u>, including the <u>Regulatory Oversight Report on Uranium and Nuclear Processing Facilities in Canada: 2019</u>. The meeting was held virtually and broadcasted on the <u>CNSC website</u>.

In April 2021, CNSC staff submitted CMD 21-M25¹ to clarify statements made during the December meeting in response to a question from the Commission regarding the regulatory requirements for the transport of natural uranium hexafluoride (UF6) in Canada. CNSC staff's original statements are reflected in paragraph 41 of the meeting minutes. The corrected paragraph should read:

41. On UF6 transportation, CNSC staff indicated that packages were designed to survive a transport accident, such as a collision. CNSC staff added that the security of the shipments was fully addressed in the transport of this material.
