CNSC decision on the allocation of participant funding for CNSC Regulatory Oversight Report for Nuclear Processing, Small Research Reactor and Class IB Accelerator Facilities: 2015

On April 7, 2016, the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) announced it was offering up to \$25,000 under its Participant Funding Program (PFP) to assist members of the public, Indigenous groups, and other stakeholders in reviewing CNSC staff's *Regulatory Oversight Report for Nuclear Processing, Small Research Reactor and Class IB Accelerator Facilities:* 2015 (2015 NPFD Report), and submitting written comments to the Commission. The deadline for submitting participant funding applications to the CNSC was June 30, 2016.

Background

Participant funding was made available by the CNSC:

- for the provision of new, distinctive and valuable information to the CNSC through informed and topic-specific interventions
- to assist interested parties in reviewing CNSC staff's 2015 NPFD Report and submitting written comments to the Commission

A funding review committee (FRC), independent of the CNSC, was established to review the funding applications received by the CNSC's PFP administrator, and to make recommendations to the CNSC on the allocation of up to \$25,000 for eligible applicants.

The FRC members were:

- Mr. Guy Riverin, environmental assessment expert and retired federal public servant
- Mr. Paul Scott, retired Regional Director of the Canadian Environmental Assessment Agency's Vancouver office
- Mr. Bruce Young, retired Canadian Environmental Assessment Agency Director

The FRC reviewed the two PFP applications received by the CNSC, requesting a total of \$33,576.55.
