# Notice of Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in January 2017 to consider McMaster University's (McMaster) proposed revised financial guarantee for the decommissioning of the McMaster Nuclear Reactor (MNR). The MNR is located on the McMaster University campus in Hamilton, ON.

McMaster has proposed a revised financial guarantee to remove its obligation to contribute further to its Nuclear Reactor Restricted Reserve Fund. McMaster has also proposed to provide a letter of acknowledgement confirming that it will assume full responsibility, including the cost, for the decommissioning of the MNR.

The Commission has determined that a hearing without interventions is appropriate to consider this application. The requested changes are administrative in nature and do not raise matters related to the protection of health, safety, security or the environment. The Commission will consider written submissions from McMaster and CNSC staff.

The hearing submissions are not available on the CNSC website and must be requested through the Secretariat at the coordinates below.
