

Notice of Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in September 2016 to consider an application from Ontario Power Generation Inc. (OPG) to amend its Nuclear Power Reactor Operating Licence (PROL) for the Pickering Nuclear Generating Station (NGS), located in Pickering, ON.

The current licence authorizes OPG to possess, transfer, manage, and store nuclear substances (including heavy water) that are required for, associated with, or arise from, the operation of the Pickering NGS. It does not currently authorize the storage of heavy water from other nuclear facilities. OPG has requested a licence amendment to allow the Pickering NGS to process, transfer, manage, and store heavy water from other nuclear facilities.

The Commission will consider OPG's application by way of written submissions, in a closed session. Members of the public who have an interest or expertise in this matter or information that may be useful to the Commission in coming to a decision are invited to comment, in writing, on OPG's application. Requests to intervene must be filed with the Commission Secretariat by **September 15, 2016** using the <u>online request form</u> or following the coordinates below. Pursuant to the *Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure*, the request to intervene must include the following information:

- a written submission of the comments to be presented to the Commission
- the requester's name, address and telephone number

All submissions are available to the public on request to the Secretariat. Personal information, such as address and telephone number, is essential for linking the submission to its author. If you wish to ensure the confidentiality of your personal information, please submit it on a separate page.

The hearing submissions are not available on the CNSC website and must be requested through the Secretariat at the coordinates below.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of Decision* will be published on the CNSC website at <u>nuclearsafety.gc.ca</u> and made available to the public on request.
