Notice of Hearing in Writing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will conduct a hearing in October 2021, based on written submissions to consider a request from Bruce Power Inc. (Bruce Power) for authorization to return Bruce Nuclear Generating Station (NGS) A Unit 3 to service, following its current planned outage. Bruce NGS A Unit 3 is <u>subject to a CNSC order</u> that requires the licensee to obtain authorization from the Commission prior to restart following any outage that results in the cooldown of the heat transport system.

Pursuant to rule 3 of the <u>Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure</u> (the Rules), the Commission has decided to vary the Rules in order to ensure that this hearing is dealt with as informally and expeditiously as the circumstances and the considerations of fairness permit. The Commission will consider written submissions from Bruce Power and CNSC staff. There is no opportunity for the public to intervene on this matter.

The hearing submissions from Bruce Power and CNSC staff will be available on the <u>CNSC</u> website, or upon request to the Secretariat, after October 1, 2021.

Following deliberations and the Commission decision on this matter, a record of decision will be published on the CNSC website at nuclearsafety.gc.ca and made available on request.
