CNSC to conduct a hearing in writing on request from Cégep de Trois-Rivières for change to the dosimetry period

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will conduct a hearing based on written submissions, in August 2023, to consider a request for an exemption from Collège d'enseignement général et professionnel (Cégep) de Trois-Rivières. Cégep de Trois-Rivières is located in Trois-Rivières, Quebec, on the traditional and unceded territory of the Abenaki people and the Wabanaki confederacy and the traditional land of the Huron-Wendat.

Pursuant to section 31(2) of the <u>Nuclear Substances and Radiation Devices Regulations</u>, the industrial radiography licensee Cégep de Trois-Rivières is required to exchange torso dosimeters every 15 days. Cégep de Trois-Rivières is requesting an exemption under section 7 of the NSCA to amend the period to exchange dosimeters from 15 days to 1 month, since the authorized users are students who use the dosimeters for 3-week periods.

Pursuant to rule 3 of the <u>Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure</u> (the Rules), the Commission has decided to vary the Rules to ensure that this hearing is dealt with as informally and expeditiously as the circumstances and the considerations of fairness permit. The Commission will consider written submissions from Cégep de Trois-Rivières and CNSC staff.

The hearing submissions from Cégep de Trois-Rivières and CNSC staff will be available on the CNSC website at <u>nuclearsafety.gc.ca</u> or on request to the Commission Registry after **July 26, 2023**.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a record of decision will be published on the CNSC website at <u>nuclearsafety.gc.ca</u> and made available on request. A decision from the Commission is anticipated by **August 31, 2023**.
