## CNSC to conduct a public hearing on Ontario Power Generation's application to renew its Darlington Waste Management Facility operating licence

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a public hearing on January 25 or 26, 2023, to consider an application from Ontario Power Generation (OPG) to renew its waste facility operating licence for the Darlington Waste Management Facility for a period of 10 years. The Darlington Waste Management Facility is located on the site of the Darlington Nuclear Generating Station in the Municipality of Clarington, Ontario, on the traditional territory of the Wendat, Anishinabek Nation, and the territory covered by the Williams Treaties with the Michi Saagiig and Chippewa Nations.

The current licence, which expires on April 30, 2023, authorizes OPG to operate the Darlington Waste Management Facility to process and store dry storage containers holding used nuclear fuel from the Darlington Nuclear Generating Station.

The public hearing will be webcast live and available on the CNSC website at <u>nuclearsafety.gc.ca</u>.

In advance of the public hearing, the CNSC is making available up to **\$75,000** in funding through its <u>Participant Funding Program</u>. The purpose of the funding is to assist Indigenous Nations and communities, members of the public and stakeholders in reviewing OPG's application and associated documents, and in participating in the Commission hearing process by providing topic-specific interventions to the Commission. Participant funding applications must clearly demonstrate how the proposed submission will provide the Commission with information directly relating to OPG's licence renewal application. Please note that the \$75,000 will be disbursed among all successful applicants. The deadline for submitting a completed participant funding application form to the CNSC is **August 19, 2022.** 

OPG's submission and CNSC staff's recommendations to be considered at the hearing will be available on the CNSC website, or on request to the Commission Registry, after **October 28**, **2022**.

Pursuant to rule 19 of the <u>Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure</u>, persons who have an interest or expertise in this matter or information that may be useful to the



Commission in coming to a decision are invited to comment on OPG's application. Requests to intervene must be filed with the Commission Registry by **November 25, 2022**, using the <u>online</u> request form or the contact information below. The request to intervene must include the following information:

- a written submission of the comments to be presented to the Commission
- a statement setting out whether the requester wishes to intervene by way of written submission only or by way of written submission and oral presentation
- the requester's name, address, telephone number and email address

All submissions will be available for download on the CNSC website or on request to the Commission Registry. Personal information, such as email address and telephone number, is essential for linking the submission to its author. If you wish to ensure the confidentiality of your personal information, please submit it on a separate page.
