## **Upcoming public meeting on the *Regulatory Oversight Report for Uranium Mines and Mills in Canada: 2021***

The [Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission](#) (CNSC) will hold a public meeting in December 2022 where CNSC staff will present the *Regulatory Oversight Report for Uranium Mines and Mills in Canada: 2021* (UMM ROR). The uranium mines and mills covered by the ROR are located in the traditional and treaty territories of many Indigenous Nations and communities. **This revised notice is to announce a change to the location of the public meeting. The meeting will now be held virtually only.**

CNSC staff will provide an overview of the CNSC's regulatory efforts related to licensed operating uranium mine and mill sites in Canada during the 2021 calendar year. The ROR will cover the following operating uranium mines and mills: Orano Canada Inc.'s McClean Lake Operation, and Cameco Corporation's Cigar Lake, Key Lake, Rabbit Lake and McArthur River operations. Historic and decommissioned sites, which are included every 3 years, are not covered in this ROR, as they were last reported on in the 2020 report.

To assist Indigenous Nations and communities, members of the public, and stakeholders in reviewing CNSC staff's UMM ROR, and as previously set out in the [notice of meeting](#) published on June 14, 2022, participant funding of up to \$75,000 was made available through the CNSC's [Participant Funding Program](#) (PFP). The deadline to submit a completed participant funding application form to the CNSC was July 15, 2022.

The deadline to submit an intervention was **November 14, 2022**. The UNSPF ROR and all interventions and submissions from CNSC staff and participants are available on the [CNSC website](#) or on request to the Registry.
