The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a public meeting during which CNSC staff will present an update to Commission members on the status of the Port Hope Area Initiative (PHAI) (www.phai.ca). The PHAI involves cleaning up historic low-level radioactive waste in the Ontario municipalities of Port Hope and Clarington. The two remediation projects under the PHAI – the Port Hope Project and the Project – are licensed by the CNSC under two 10-year Waste Nuclear Substance Licences issued to Canadian Nuclear Laboratories Limited (CNL). The Commission was last updated on the status of the PHAI during a Commission meeting held on December 17–18, 2014.

The public meeting will be webcast live and archived for 90 days on the CNSC website at nuclearsafety.gc.ca.

Through its Participant Funding Program, the CNSC is offering up to \$25,000 in funding to assist members of the public, Aboriginal groups and other stakeholders in reviewing CNSC staff's status report on the PHAI and participating in the Commission meeting process by providing topic-specific submissions to the Commission.

The deadline for submitting a completed participant funding application form to the CNSC is **June 30, 2016**.

Additionally, members of the public who have an interest or expertise on this matter or information that may be useful to the Commission are invited to comment on CNSC staff's status update. Requests to participate must be filed with the Commission Secretariat by October 3, 2016 using the online request form at nuclearsafety.gc.ca/eng/the-commission/intervention or following the coordinates below. The request to participate must include the following information:

- a written submission of the comments to be presented to the Commission
- a statement setting out whether the requester wishes to participate by way of written submission only or by way of written submission and oral presentation
