Regulatory Oversight Report for Canadian Nuclear Power Plants: 2015

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a public meeting during which CNSC staff will present its *Regulatory Oversight Report for Canadian Nuclear Power Plants:* 2015 (2015 NPP Report). This report provides CNSC staff's assessment of the Canadian nuclear power industry's safety performance during the 2015 calendar year and details the progress of regulatory issues and initiatives up to April 30, 2016.

The public meeting will be webcast live and archived for 90 days on the CNSC website at nuclearsafety.gc.ca.

Through its Participant Funding Program, the CNSC is offering up to \$35,000 in funding to assist members of the public, Aboriginal groups and other stakeholders in reviewing CNSC staff's 2015 NPP Report and participating in the Commission meeting process by providing topic-specific written submissions to the Commission. The deadline for submitting a completed participant funding application form to the CNSC is **May 6, 2016**.

The 2015 NPP report will be available online after **June 13, 2016**, or by request through the Secretariat at the coordinates below. Agendas, meeting transcripts and information on the public Commission meeting process are available on the <u>CNSC website</u>.

Members of the public who have an interest or expertise on this matter, or information that may be useful to the Commission, are invited to comment, in writing, on the 2015 NPP Report. Written submissions must be filed with the Commission Secretariat by **July 14, 2016** using the online request form at http://www.nuclearsafety.gc.ca/eng/the-commission/intervention or following the coordinates below. The submission must include your name, address and telephone number.
