Regulatory Oversight Report for Canadian Nuclear Power Plants: 2016

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a public meeting during which CNSC staff will present its *Regulatory Oversight Report for Canadian Nuclear Power Plants: 2016* (2016 NPP Report). This report provides CNSC staff's assessment of the Canadian nuclear power industry's safety performance during the 2016 calendar year and details the progress of regulatory issues and initiatives up to April 30, 2017.

The public meeting will be webcast live and available for 90 days on the CNSC website at nuclearsafety.gc.ca.

Through its Participant Funding Program, the CNSC is offering up to **\$35,000** in funding to assist members of the public, Indigenous groups and other stakeholders in reviewing CNSC staff's 2016 NPP Report and participating in the Commission meeting process by providing topic-specific submissions to the Commission. The deadline for submitting a completed participant funding application form to the CNSC is **April 28, 2017**.

The 2016 NPP Report will be available after **June 16, 2017**, online or by request to the Secretariat. Further information on the public Commission meeting process is available on the CNSC website.
