## Notice of Hearing in Writing

February 28, 2020

Ref. 2020-H-100

In March 2020, the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will conduct a hearing based on written submissions. The hearing will be to consider applications from Ontario Power Generation, New Brunswick Power Corporation and Bruce Power (the licensees) to amend their nuclear power reactor operating licences, in order to implement CNSC regulatory document REGDOC-2.2.3, *Personnel Certification, Volume III: Certification of Persons Working at Nuclear Power Plants.* 

The current licences authorize the licensees to operate their nuclear power reactor facilities, comprising CANDU reactor units, with a licence condition requiring the implementation of RD-204, *Certification of Persons Working at Nuclear Power Plants*. RD-204 was recently replaced with REGDOC-2.2.3, and the licensees are seeking a licence amendment to reflect this change in their licences.

Pursuant to Rule 3 of the *Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure* (the Rules), the Commission has decided to vary the Rules in order to ensure that this hearing is dealt with as informally and expeditiously as the circumstances and the considerations of fairness permit. The Commission will consider written submissions from the licensees and CNSC staff. A panel of the Commission will then deliberate and render a decision on the applications.

The hearing submissions from the licensees and CNSC staff will be available on the CNSC website, or on request to the Secretariat, after **February 28, 2020** 

Following the deliberations and Commission decision on this matter, a record of decision will be published on the CNSC website at <u>nuclearsafety.gc.ca</u> and made available on request.
