

## Notice of Participation at a Commission Meeting and Participant Funding

Upcoming public meeting on the Regulatory Oversight Report on the Use of Nuclear Substances in Canada: 2020

In November 2021, the <u>Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission</u> (CNSC) will hold a public meeting where CNSC staff will present the *Regulatory Oversight Report on the Use of Nuclear Substances in Canada:* 2020 (ROR).

The ROR provides CNSC staff's assessment of the safety performance of licensees in the medical, industrial, academic and research, and commercial sectors that used nuclear substances in Canada in 2020.

Date: November 24–25, 2021

Place: To be determined (at this time, a virtual meeting)

Time: As set by the agenda published prior to the meeting date

The public meeting will be webcast live and available on the CNSC website at nuclearsafety.gc.ca.

In advance of the public meeting, the CNSC is making available up to \$10,000 in funding through its Participant Funding Program (PFP). The purpose of the funding is to assist Indigenous peoples, members of the public and stakeholders in reviewing CNSC staff's ROR and participating in the Commission meeting process by providing topic-specific written submissions to the Commission. Applications for participant funding must clearly demonstrate how the proposed intervention will provide the Commission with information directly relating to the ROR, or safety performance by nuclear substances licensees during 2020. Please note that the \$15,000 will be disbursed among all successful applicants. The deadline for submitting a completed participant funding application form to the CNSC is **August 6, 2021**.

The ROR will be available for review on the CNSC website, or on request to the Secretariat, after **September 9, 2021.** 

Persons who have an interest or expertise in this matter are invited to comment, in writing, on the ROR by **October 25, 2021** using the <u>online request form</u> or the contact information below. The submission must include your name, address, telephone number and email address. In addition, the CNSC will allow Indigenous intervenors the opportunity to make oral presentations in the



spirit of reconciliation and in recognition of the Indigenous oral tradition for sharing knowledge. Oral presentations will be conducted remotely.

All submissions will be available for download on the CNSC website or on request to the Secretariat. Personal information, such as address and telephone number, is essential for linking the submission to its author. If you wish to ensure the confidentiality of your personal information, please submit it on a separate page.
