Upcoming public meeting on the Regulatory Oversight Report for Uranium Mines, Mills, Historic, and Decommissioned Sites in Canada: 2020

The <u>Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission</u> (CNSC) will hold a public meeting in December 2021, where CNSC staff will present the *Regulatory Oversight Report for Uranium Mines, Mills, Historic, and Decommissioned Sites in Canada: 2020* (UMM ROR). The UMM ROR will provide an overview of CNSC regulatory efforts in 2020 with respect to operating uranium mines and mills in Canada.

The public meeting will be webcast live and available on the CNSC website at nuclearsafety.gc.ca.

In advance of the public meeting, the CNSC is making available up to \$75,000 in funding through its Program. The purpose of the funding is to assist Indigenous peoples, members of the public and stakeholders in reviewing CNSC staff's UMM ROR and in participating in the Commission meeting process by providing topic-specific written submissions to the Commission. Participant funding applications must clearly demonstrate how the proposed submission will provide the Commission with information directly relating to the UMM ROR and the regulatory performance of operating uranium mines and mills in 2020. Please note that the \$75,000 will be disbursed among all successful applicants. The deadline for submitting a completed participant funding application form to the CNSC is **August 13, 2021**.

The UMM ROR will be available for review on the CNSC website, or on request to the Secretariat, after **September 16, 2021**.

Persons who have an interest or expertise in this matter are invited to comment, in writing, on the UMM ROR by **November 15, 2021**, using the <u>online request form</u> or the contact information below. The submission must include your name, address, telephone number and email address. In addition, in the spirit of reconciliation and in recognition of the Indigenous oral tradition for sharing knowledge, the CNSC will offer Indigenous intervenors the opportunity to make oral presentations. Oral presentations will be conducted remotely.
