The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in April 2016 to consider a request from New Brunswick Power Corporation (NB Power) to modify the used fuel and waste management funds investment strategy for the Point Lepreau Nuclear Generating Station (NGS). The Point Lepreau NGS is located in New Brunswick on the Lepreau Peninsula, 40 km southwest of Saint John.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider this application. The requested changes are administrative in nature and do not raise matters related to the protection of health, safety, security or the environment that would warrant being considered in a public hearing. The Commission will consider written submissions from NB Power and CNSC staff.

The hearing submissions are not available on the CNSC website and must be requested through the Secretariat at the coordinates below.

Following the deliberations in a closed session and Commission decision on this matter, a *Record of Proceedings, Including Reasons for Decision* will be published on the CNSC website at nuclearsafety.gc.ca and made available to the public on request.
