

Notice of Postponement of Public Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) is postponing a public hearing that had been scheduled for August 19–20, 2020. The hearing was to consider the application from Canadian Nuclear Laboratories Limited (CNL) to amend its waste facility decommissioning licence for the Douglas Point Waste Facility (DPWF), located on the Bruce Power site in Tiverton, Ontario.

On April 30, 2020, CNL requested that the Commission postpone the hearing to consider the DPWF until fall 2020. In its request, CNL explained that the restrictions brought about by the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic presented challenges, and that it required additional time to carry out adequate pre-hearing engagement activities.

The public hearing to consider CNL's application for the amendment of the DPWF licence will take place at a later date. A revised notice of public hearing will be issued and will provide information in respect of the opportunity for the public to participate in the hearing.
