Revised Notice of Public Hearing

In its continued response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) postponed the public hearing to consider an application from Canadian Nuclear Laboratories Limited (CNL) to amend its waste facility decommissioning licence for the Douglas Point Waste Facility (DPWF). The public hearing, scheduled to be held on August 19 and 20, 2020, will now be held on November 25 and 26, 2020.

The DPWF is the site of the former 200 MW Douglas Point power reactor and is located on the Bruce Power site in Tiverton, Ontario. The Douglas Point reactor was permanently shut down in 1984 and has been in Phase 2 of decommissioning – storage with surveillance – since 1988. CNL is now requesting a licence amendment to authorize Phase 3 of the DPWF decommissioning project, which would include the active decommissioning and demolition of remaining facilities.

Requests to intervene must be filed with the Commission Secretariat by October 26, 2020, via the online request form or the contact information below. The request to intervene must include the following information:

- a written submission of the comments to be presented to the Commission
- a statement setting out whether the requester wishes to intervene by way of written submission only, or by way of written submission and oral presentation
- the requester's name, address, telephone number and email address

All submissions will be available for download on the CNSC website or on request to the Secretariat. Personal information, such as email address and telephone number, is essential for linking the submission to its author. If you wish to ensure the confidentiality of your personal information, please submit it on a separate page.
