



Revised Notice of Public Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) announces changes to both the location and date for Part 2 of the public hearing being held in June 2018 to consider an application from Ontario Power Generation Inc. (OPG) to renew its Nuclear Power Reactor Operating Licence for the Pickering Nuclear Generating Station (NGS) for a period of 10 years.

Following a change in availability of the Pickering Recreation Complex in Pickering, ON during the week of the public hearing on OPG's licence renewal application, the CNSC is pleased to announce that the hearing will now be held at this facility, which is in the community where the Pickering NGS is located.

Further, in light of the interventions to be considered during the public hearing, two days (June 25 and 29) have been added to the hearing.

Hearing Part 1 was held in Ottawa on April 4, 2018.
