

Notice of Hearing in Writing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in writing in February 2018 to consider an application from Canadian Light Source Inc. (CLSI) requesting approval for a change to the licensing basis for its Class IB synchrotron facility, located on the University of Saskatchewan campus in Saskatoon, SK. CLSI operates its synchrotron facility in accordance with its Class IB Particle Accelerator Operating Licence.

The current licence authorizes CLSI to operate the facility in the standard mode of operation. CLSI has requested Commission approval to implement a continuous electron top-up mode of operation.

Pursuant to rule 3 of the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure (the Rules), the Commission has decided to vary the Rules in order to ensure that this hearing is dealt with as informally and expeditiously as the circumstances and the considerations of fairness permit. The Commission will consider written submissions from CLSI and CNSC staff. A panel of the Commission will then deliberate and render a decision on CLSI's application.

The hearing submissions are not available on the CNSC website and must be requested through the Secretariat at the coordinates below.

Following the deliberations and Commission decision on this matter, a *Record of Decision* will be published on the CNSC website at nuclearsafety.gc.ca and made available on request.
