

Notice of Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in June 2016 to consider an application from the Corporation of École Polytechnique de Montréal (Polytechnique Montréal) to revoke its Non-Power Subcritical Assembly Operating Licence and amend its SLOWPOKE-2 Non-Power Reactor Operating Licence to include activities related to the non-power subcritical assembly. The Commission will also consider Polytechnique Montréal's revised Financial Guarantee and updated Preliminary Decommissioning Plan.

The Polytechnique Montréal is located on the campus of the Université de Montréal in Montréal, QC.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider this application. The requested changes are administrative in nature and do not raise matters related to the protection of health, safety, security and the environment that would warrant being considered in a public hearing. The Commission will consider written submissions from Polytechnique Montréal and CNSC staff.

The hearing submissions are not available on the CNSC website and must be requested through the Secretariat at the coordinates below.

Following the deliberations in a closed session and Commission decision on this matter, a Record of Decision will be published on the CNSC website at nuclearsafety.gc.ca and made available to the public on request.
