# *Notice of Hearing in Writing*

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will conduct a hearing based on written submissions in July 2018 to consider a licence amendment application from AREVA Resources Canada Inc. (AREVA). AREVA has an amendment to the McClean Lake Uranium Mine Operating Licence to change the licensee name from AREVA Resources Canada Inc. to Orano Canada Inc. This is strictly a name change and does not represent a change in corporate entity.

AREVA's uranium mine operating licence authorizes it to operate the McClean Lake uranium mine and mill facility, located in Northern Saskatchewan.

Pursuant to rule 3 of the *Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure* (the Rules), the Commission has decided to vary the Rules in order to ensure that this hearing is dealt with as informally and expeditiously as the circumstances and the considerations of fairness permit. The Commission will consider written submissions from AREVA and CNSC staff. A panel of the Commission will then deliberate and render a decision on AREVA's application.

The hearing submissions will be available on the CNSC website, or on request to the Secretariat, on **June 18, 2018**.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a record of decision will be published on the CNSC website at [nuclearsafety.gc.ca](http://nuclearsafety.gc.ca) and made available on request.
