

Notice of Hearing in Writing

December 14, 2018 Ref. 2018-H-107

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will conduct a hearing in January 2019, based on written submissions. This hearing will consider the application from Canadian Nuclear Laboratories (CNL) to replace the Waste Facility Decommissioning Licence (WFDL) for the following three facilities with three separate licences:

- Gentilly-1 (located in Bécancour, Québec)
- Douglas Point (located in Kincardine, Ontario)
- Nuclear Power Demonstration (located in Rolphton, Ontario)

CNL currently holds WFDL-W 4-332.01/2034, which authorizes storage-with-surveillance activities at the Gentilly-1, Nuclear Power Demonstration and Douglas Point sites. CNL is requesting to replace the current single licence with three licences (one for each site), with no change to the licensed activities authorized by the Commission, and with the licence expiry date remaining December 31, 2034.

Pursuant to rule 3 of the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure (the Rules), the Commission has decided to vary the Rules to ensure that this hearing is dealt with as informally and expeditiously as the circumstances and the considerations of fairness permit. The Commission will consider written submissions from CNL and CNSC staff, and a panel of the Commission will then deliberate and render a decision on CNL's application.

The hearing submissions from CNL and CNSC staff are available on the CNSC website, or on request to the Secretariat.

Following the deliberations and Commission decision on this matter, a record of decision will be published on the CNSC website at nuclearsafety.gc.ca and made available on request.
