Immediately ensure i) all nuclear substances and radiation devices under their expired licence remain secured in their current installed locations, consistent with the conditions observed by inspectors on January 13, 2026; ii) no use, dismounting, servicing, or maintenance of the radiation devices or handling of nuclear substances is conducted by employees of Dart Canada Inc.; iii) prudent security measures are in place and maintained to prevent unauthorized access to nuclear substances and radiation devices; and iv) radiation warning signs required under the Radiation Protection Regulations remain posted, visible, and legible.

5b. This order is closed when all terms listed in 5a of this form have been fulfilled, and All nuclear substances and radiation devices, previously licensed under CNSC licence 08046-1-25.0, are in the possession of a CNSC licensee by January 28, 2026.

6. Information on which order is based 1. The licensee's CNSC licence (08046-1-25.0) authorizing the possession, transfer, import, export, use, and storage of radiation devices has expired on May 31, 2025, and is no longer valid. The radiation devices have not been in use since May 5, 2025. 2. The RSO informed CNSC on May 6, 2025 that a source removal quote was received from Honeywell. At that time, the RSO was awaiting internal authorization to issue the purchase order. 3. The RSO believed he was permitted to transfer the radiation devices after the licence had expired. 4. On January 13, 2026, CNSC staff conducted an inspection at 2121 Markham Rd in Scarborough, ON and confirmed the presence of 6 Honeywell model 2201 radiation devices on site, identified by the following serial numbers: NM379, MN378, MN 377, MN 376, PF 174, and PF 175. 5. On January 13, 2026, Mark Emerson, Plant Manager and the Signing Authority for the CNSC licence, provided a verbal commitment to CNSC staff to maintain security of the devices until the nuclear substances and radiation devices are under regulatory control. 6. On January 14, 2026, Mark Emerson stated he provided a purchase order to CNSC licensee Honeywell Limited (15858) to obtain the sources. 7. Based on conversation with Mark Emerson and Joseph Mensah (RSO) on January 15, 2026, action plan was provided to have sources removed by January 28, 2026.
