Actions or measures required to be taken by licensee and/or other person(s) (specify) in respect of any facility, place, substance, vehicle, equipment or information (specify), including any time limits or restrictions Canadian Nuclear Laboratories Limited (CNL) is ordered to take possession of, and further manage, the identified radioactive waste located at [redacted] Toronto. The radioactive waste subject to this order were cordoned off with radiation warning tape and assessed by a CNSC Inspector, on September 5, 2025. The radioactive waste is currently in the possession of a member of the public, [redacted] who is not licensed nor qualified to manage the waste. CNL is further ordered to take any additional measures that are necessary to return the property to a radiological state that is acceptable for occupancy by members of the public. Information on which order is based This work shall be conducted under CNL's Waste Nuclear Substance Licence (WNSL) WNSL-W2-2202.0/2026. WNSL-W2-2202.0/2026 authorizes the licensee [CNL] to possess, transfer, use, process, manage, and store, subject to the conditions of this licence, the nuclear substances, except Category I, II and III nuclear material as defined in section 1 of the Nuclear Security Regulations, that are required for, associated with or arise from historic waste remediation operations as more precisely described in Appendix A. Appendix A states "Historic waste is defined as radioactively contaminated materials for which the producer cannot be reasonably held responsible and for which the federal government has accepted responsibility." The CNSC has reason to believe that the contamination present at the property arose from historic industrial practices. CNL is being issued this order as the sole company that holds a licence under which the work can be performed, and that CNL has competent and qualified staff that can carry out the work. ORDERS OF AN INSPECTOR

38 Every order of an inspector and every order of a designated officer under paragraph 37(2)(f) shall be made, and every measure under paragraph 37(2)(c), (d) or (g) shall be taken, in accordance with the *Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure*.

COMPLIANCE WITH ORDER

41 Every person named in or subject to an order of the Commission, an inspector or designated officer shall, regardless of whether or not the person has had an opportunity to make representations with respect to the order, comply with the order within the time specified in it or, if no time is specified, immediately.
